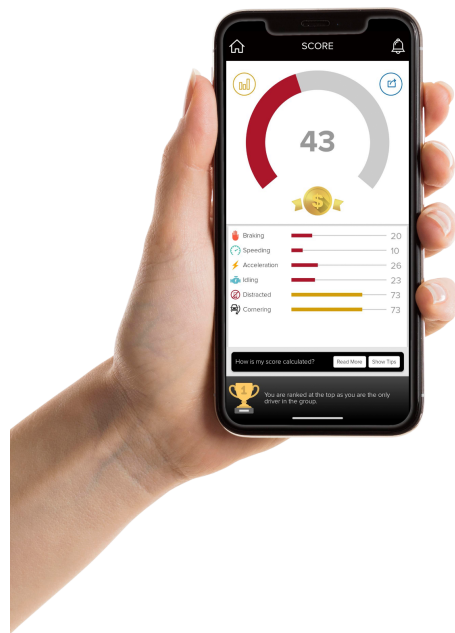

AZUGA FLEET MOBILE QUICK START GUIDE

The Azuga FleetMobile is an app that can be used by fleet managers and drivers. It lets drivers view their safety scores, compete with other drivers, receive rewards on their phone, execute jobs, record shift activities, and view vehicle data. Fleet managers can use the same to track and manage their fleet.

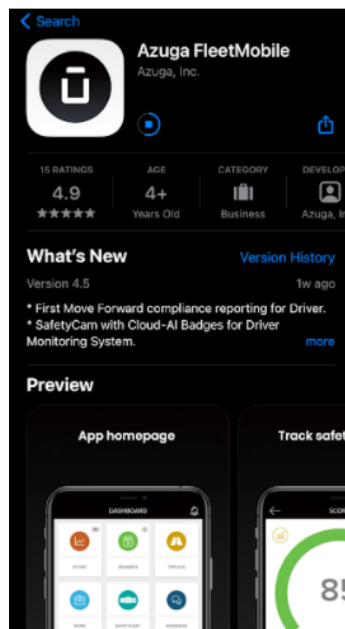
Minimum system requirements

For iOS: Compatible on iOS devices running iOS version 10 and above.

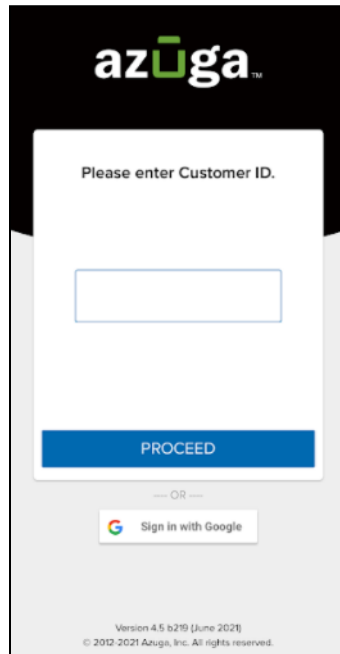
For Android: Compatible on android devices running Android version 5 and above.

Getting Started

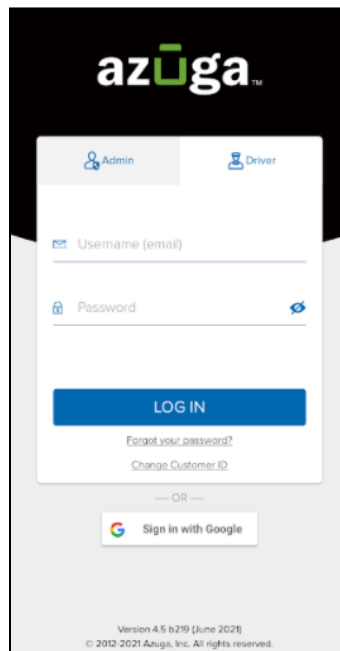
1. Search for Azuga FleetMobile on the Play Store App Store.
2. Tap **Get** and then tap **Install** to download the app.
 - For iOS, enter your Apple account password or Touch ID, if prompted.
 - For Android, enter your Google account password



3. Launch the app. Enter the customer ID and tap **Proceed**.




4. Enter the Username & Password / PIN / Employee ID and tap **LOG IN**.




You can log in to the app using your email account, PIN, or employee ID. This is controlled by a preference (Mobile App Login Type) on the Azuga Web application. The app displays the appropriate menus based on your login: As a driver, or as a fleet manager.

5. Review your login details and tap **LOG IN**.

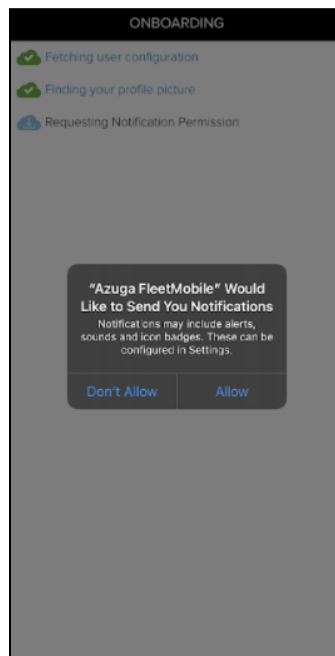
*To reset your password, tap the **Forgot your password link** and enter your email address. We'll send you an email with the instructions.*

6. Read and accept the Azuga Terms and Conditions in the **EULA** screen and click on **ACCEPT**.

8. Wait for the user onboarding process to complete and then tap **Continue** to finish the setup and start using the app.



9. Once the setup is completed, the dashboard will display a list of available options to choose from.
